

Selection of Visiting Professor Fellowship in Brazil under the Institutional Internationalization Program - CAPES - Print

The program provides the opportunity for 1 professor from foreign institutions with relevant academic scientific experience to visit our Institution for a period of 15 days in the months of July, August and September 2020.

The following documents are required for registration:

1. Document certifying residency and link with a teaching/ research institution abroad;
2. Document proving the partnership, dated and signed, on letterhead, informing month and year of beginning and end of the stay, preferably with a protocol of intention or specific agreement with the researcher's;
3. Curriculum Vitae of the applicant;
4. Updated ORCID record;
5. Work plan to be developed during the stay in Brazil, containing the following items:
 - Activities to be developed (courses, training, lectures or seminars);
 - Justification, presenting the topicality and relevance of the theme of the activities, their adherence to the Institutional Project for Internationalization at UFRJ and, if applicable, also to the project in international cooperation;
 - Clear definition and delimitation of the object of study;
 - Goals and objectives;
 - Chronogram.
